Academic Year 2018-2019 Fellowships

CeLTA fellowships are open to language teaching faculty and language teaching graduate students who wish to pursue a project that is beyond the scope of their regular teaching, research, or curricular development duties. These projects may be focused on research, materials development, or outreach, but should contribute to advancing language instruction at MSU and be effective and innovative in nature.

Awards will be announced in September 2018 for the 2018-2019 academic year. Project activity is to be completed by May 2019. Awards will range from \$1,000 - \$2,000.

Recipients are expected to participate in brief monthly meetings throughout each semester to update CeLTA on their project progress. Recipients will also present their preliminary project ideas during the CeLTA PD series in fall 2018 on Wednesday, October 10 from 1-2 pm and their results in spring 2018 (date TBD). At the end of the project, fellows will be required to submit a report.

Please submit all of the following:

- Application form (below)
- A two-page CV
- A two-page description of your project

The description of your project should include:

1. A rationale
2. A description of the research design, project, or materials to be developed
3. A time line for the implementation of the project over fall 2017 and spring 2018
4. Expected results and their impact on your career, on the department, and on the field
5. Explanation of how your project benefits the teaching and research mission of your department and/or your professional development
